THE PORTFOLIO

- Projects that are worked on during the odd semester of the academic year 2018-19. It should carry a range of works from initial working process to final presentation.
- The YUGTO '19 theme "Transition". Highlight the instances in submission which includes challenged design boundaries, experimented and innovated them.





SUBMISSION DETAILS

RULES

- Maximum of 3 entries per year.
- Respective design brief provided by the participant's institution for the academic design project should be submitted.
- Projects done in the odd semester of the academic year 2018-19 is permitted.
- The candidates are instructed to submit their individual works.
- 1st year can submit the works of Visual Arts, Basic Design, Photography and Architectural Sketching etc.
- The submitted works should be documented as a PDF format.
- Maximum of 6 pages should be documented (including Introduction sheet) based on Transition.
- Design brief of submitted works ought to be given during the registration.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- The format should clearly mention "YUGTO ARCHITECTON TROPHY: (Registration Code)" at the right bottom corner of all the sheets.
- Also mention "CATEGORY: 1ST/2ND/3RD/4TH/5TH YEAR" at the below the registration code of all the sheets.
 - The entry code will be provided after the registration.

NOTE: The identity of participants by any means should not feature in any of the sheets. All participants are requested to adhere to the mentioned specifications, failing which the entry will be disqualified.
